5. Examine the major steps taken for disarmament since the World War-II.
6. Analyse the role of the ASEAN as a regional organisation in international politics.

SECOND HALF

7. Analyse the view that the Peace of Westphalia is the founding moment of modern international community.
8. Do you agree with the view that international law is transforming into supernational law? Discuss.
9. Examine the collective security measures, as described in the charter of the United Nations.
10. Make an assessment of the peace-keeping functions of the United Nations in the post-Cold War period.
11. Discuss, in detail, the major provisions for the legal control of war under the UN Charter.
12. Comment on the evolving role of the Economic and Social Council as a major organ of the UN.
