- (d) Explain Lamb's feeling of 'passing into another world' after superannuation.
- (e) Which advice of Iago does Shaw refer to in 'Freedom'? Why is the advice not practical in recent times?
- (f) How does Shaw criticise Trade Unionism in his essay Freedom?
- (g) How does Forster deal with the charge of hypocrisy against the English?
- (h) What, according to Forster, is the Englishman's attitude towards criticism?
- (i) What does Orwell mean when he says 'A sahib has got to act like a sahib'?

- (j) Why did Orwell suffer from 'an intolerable sense of guilt' while working for the British Empire?
- (k) Why does Huxley, in his essay, put the word 'pleasure' within inverted commas?
- (1) Why does Huxley think that the modern mind is 'atrophied'?
