রেজল্যুশন / Resolution Adopted

- The resolutions of the previous meetings were confirmed.
- The departmental committee has unanimously resolved that a proposal will be send to DBT, Govt. of WB for BOOST –II program in the prescribed format outlining the details of the Department. The head of the department will act as standing coordinator of the BOOST –II program. Dr. S Acharya is assigned the responsibility prepare the proposal and to collect all the required quotations and also to proceed for the procuring the same in consultation with other faculties of the department as n when required. The DC also resolved that following instruments will be sought from the equipment grant of the said program.
