Resolutions:

1. Proceedings of the last DC meeting held on 01. 08. 2020 were read and confirmed.
2. Members of the DC thoroughly examined and discussed the final technical report of the recently concluded UGC-SAP program, submitted by Prof. Braja Gopal Bag, Coordinator of the said program. Members were in the opinion that the report might be submitted to the UGC as per norms. Members also requested Prof. Braja Gopal Bag, Coordinator, UGC-SAP and Prof. Ajay Kumar Misra, Deputy Coordinator, UGC-SAP to continue their activities until the submission of FTR at the earliest. DC also resolves to extend all kind of support and consultation/discussion as and whenever required.
3. Purchase procedure of the CD spectrometer and AFM:
 - a. Prof. Amiya Kumar Panda, Coordinator, and Dr. Maidul Hossain, Deputy Coordinator, ongoing DST-FIST Program have reported that two companies have responded to the tender for the purchase of the circular dichroism (CD) spectrophotometer. It was informed that it was the second re-e-tender for the CD spectrometer. Dr. Maidul Hossain and Dr. Anirban Basu have thoroughly checked the technical details and have found them to be in order. The technical details were also sent to all the members of the DC for their opinion. It was finally decided that the next course of action, i.e., opening of the financial bid may be initiated. The concerned authority may be informed accordingly for further processing in this regard.
 - b. Prof. Amiya Kumar Panda, Coordinator, and Dr. Maidul Hossain, Deputy Coordinator, ongoing DST-FIST Program have reported that three companies have responded to the tender for the purchase of the Atomic Force Microscope (AFM) in response to the e-tender for the second time. It was also reported that the specification of the AFM was recommended by an Expert Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The members opined that the

technical details of submitted by different companies/agencies may be sent to the Expert Committee for their opinion.

4. The members opined that a meeting of the Ph. D. committee may be scheduled in the second/third week of September, 2020 in consultation with the Dean, Faculty of Science and the external members of the Ph. D. Committee.
5. Discussion on the details of the maintenance of the NMR and SEM was deferred to the next meeting of the DC.
6. Misc.
 - a. HoD requested the members of the DC to complete course work of the ongoing session of the Ph. D. program, preferably by the third week of September, 2020
 - b. The DC also resolves to request the University authority in approving the expenditure incurred by Professor Braja Gopal Bag, Coordinator, UGC SAP during the lockdown period for filling up liquid nitrogen/helium in the NMR instrument, as the relevant expenditures could not be incurred before the date of completion of the program due to the Covid Pandemic.
 - c. Members of the DC requested the HoD to write to the authority in providing a manpower in the post of Mr. Subrata Kumar Hazra, who has recently retired.
 - d. The DC resolves to organize a one-day Webinar entitled "Recent Advancements in Fluorescence Spectroscopy", in collaboration with the Department of Chemistry, Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur under the aegis of the the Chemical Research Society of India, Kharagpur Local Chapter. Prof. Swagata Dasgupta is the Convener and Prof. Amiya Kumar Panda is the Co-convener of the said local chapter. The DC proposes the name of Prof. Ajay Kumar Misra to act as the Convener of the Program. The duration of the one-day seminar will be about four hours, starting from 11 am., with a lunch break. The speakers (provisional) include Prof. Anunay Samanta, University of Hyderabad, Prof. Nilmoni Sarkar, Dept. of Chemistry, IIT, Kgp, Prof. Nikhil Guchait, Dept. of Chemistry, CU, and Prof. Anindya Dutta, IIT, Bombay. It has also been reported by Prof. Amiya Kumar Panda that the entire program would involve no financial support, except the IT support from the University Computer Centre. The DC resolves to seek kind permission from the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in this regard.
