1. Show how relations of production changed as the traditional cottage industry was transformed into the modern factory industry?

- 2. What is Agricultural Revolution? What changes in cultivation practices and systems of land holding brought this about in modern Europe?
- 3. Why was technology a more important factor in continental industrial revolution than that of England?
- 4. Why was there no industrial revolution in France up to 1789? What problems did the revolution itself create?
- 5. Assess the importance of Zollverin and the railways in 19th Century German industrialisation.
- 6. What policies and initiatives did the Russian State adopt to overcome a shortage of capital in the 19th century?

GROUP-B

- 7. Discuss the nature of pre-industrial economy, indicating the specific differences with industrial capitalist economy.
- 8. Discuss the positive aspects of State intervention in facilitating the process of industrial change in England in the 18th century.
- 9. Discuss how Bank of England and the government of Britain promoted the availability of necessary capital and funds for industrialisation.
- 10. Compare and contrast the diffusion of innovations in the technology of iron and cotton industry.
- 11. Do you think that the statistical evidences on the prices of some essential commodities and wages of the industrial workers can give a proper picture of the standard of living of labour in early industrial England?
