Group-A

- 1. Review the Afghan polity that prevailed in India on the eve of Babur's invasion in 1526.
- 2. Discuss critically the Mughal Afghan contest that took place in India between 1530 & 1555. Trace the causes of Humayun's failure.
- 3. What was the nature of territorial expansion under the Mughals immediately after the assumption of political power by Akbar.
- 4. Describe with reference to the central, provincial and local administration the structure of the Mughal state apparatus.

- .5. Describe in detail the organizational structure of the military system under the Mughals.
- 6. Discuss critically the different types of land revenue demands prevalent in Mughal India as shown in the contemporary documents.

- 7. Critically discuss the achievements of Peshwa Baji Rao I.
- 8. Would you argue that the continuous. oppression on the peasant society ultimately created acute agrarian crisis in the Mughal India? How did the peasants protest against it?
- 9. Analyse the technological skill and enterprise of the artisans in Mughal India in ship-building and canon-making industry. Would you argue that Indian artisans backed the enterprise to transform the industry?
- 10. What were the different types of inland trade in Mughal India and how were they related to a hierarchy of markets?
- 11. Trace the development of the currency system in Mughal India, emphasizing the initiatives of Akbar as a reformer in this regard.
- 12. How does Athar Ali's concept of cultural backwardness qualify Irfan Habib's thesis of agrarian crisis and Satish Chandra's views of administrative crisis?
